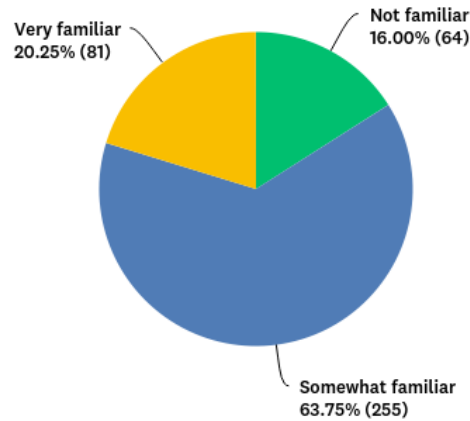
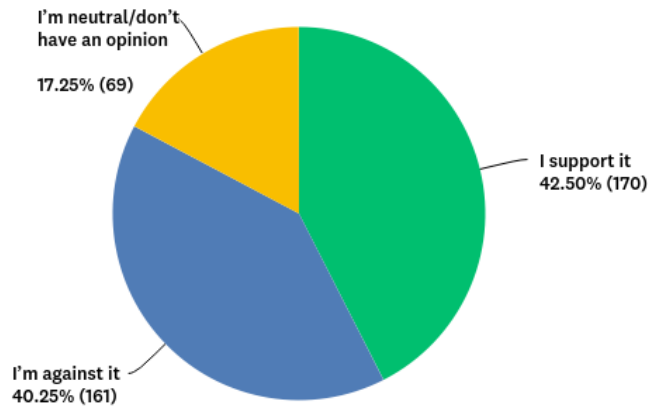


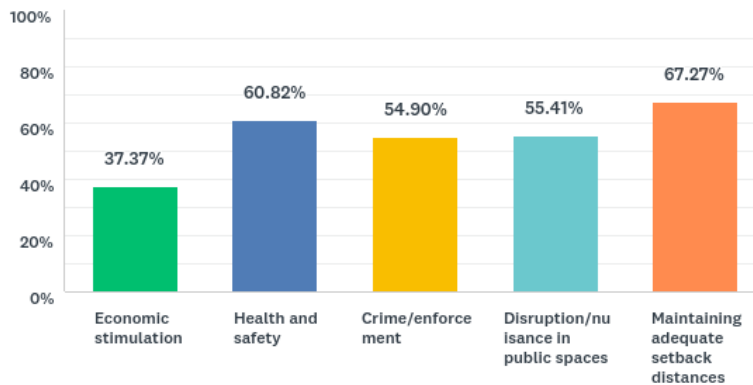
Q1 How familiar are you with the impending legalization of cannabis and each level of government's roles and responsibilities in its implementation? (federal, provincial, municipal)



Q2 Generally speaking, what is your overall feeling toward the legalization of non-medical (recreational) cannabis?



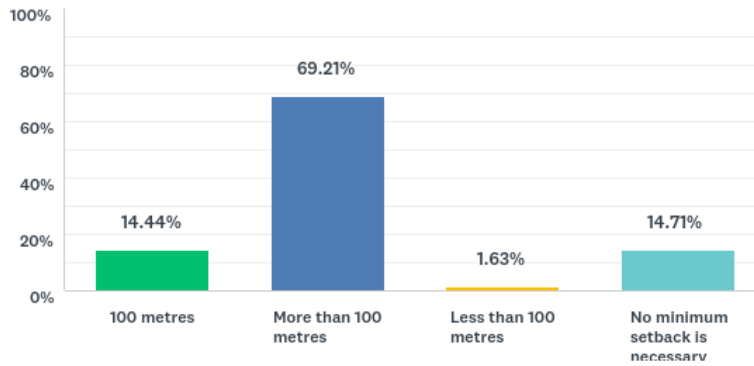

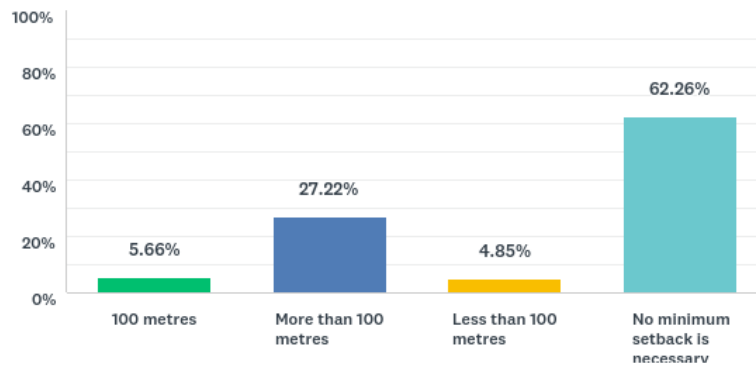
Q6 What do you feel is an acceptable minimum setback distance for cannabis retailers (stores) to be located from PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS?



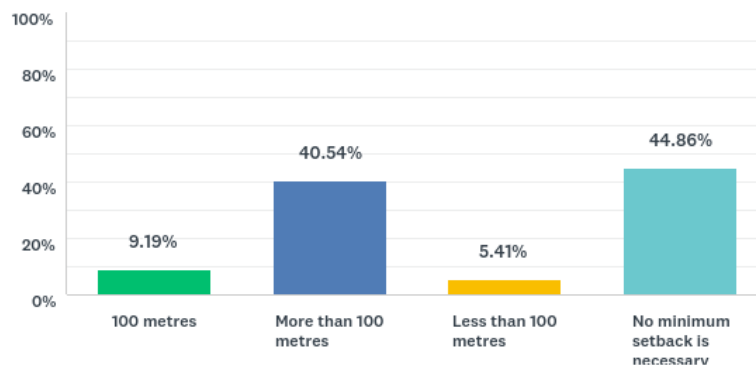
