

Frequently Asked Questions

How long can I park my trailer or Motorhome on the street? All recreational vehicles are permitted to be parked on the street for a period of 72 hours at a time, then must be moved to an off highway location for a minimum of 48 hours before returning.

Can I park my trailer on the street unattached? No, unattached trailers must be parked on private property.

Are there any parking restrictions for trailers or motorhomes on my property? Yes, all trailers/ motorhomes must be either parked along side portion or in rear portion of your property from Oct. 31- Apr 1.

What is a Street Maintenance zone? Anywhere there is "No Parking" signs posted prior to/during maintenance being conducted on the street or immediate area. This includes snow removal, street sweeping, road construction, adjacent tree maintenance, etc. Vehicles could be towed or ticketed.

How much notice do I get when Street Maintenance Zone is put into effect? Signs will be posted 24 hours prior to work being done to give residents sufficient notice to move vehicles. In the event of emergency, signs may be posted immediately, vehicles may be removed, however every effort will be made to contact vehicle owners first.

When might my property be considered a Nuisance? When anything that is visible from outside your property may make property appear unsightly or pose a potential safety or health risk to other residents. Examples: old interior furniture or appliances kept outside, derelict vehicles or vehicle parts spread throughout property, tall grass (taller than 15 cm), and weeds throughout property
Investigating Community Peace Officer will determine complaint upon arrival to property in question.

What is a Derelict Vehicle? A vehicle incapable of proper operation, stored visible from outside property, and makes property appear unsightly.

What time do Noise regulations take effect in town? Residential areas - in effect 24 hours/day. Construction - 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Mon - Sat, and 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. Sun.

Is there a curfew in town? Yes, all children under 16 years must be accompanied by an adult in a public place between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. Exceptions given on any day due to his/her employment or while returning home from an organized sporting or other event that has been supervised by an adult.
